Lent: Listening To God Through Luke

This Lent we will be reading a portion of Luke each day to grow in faith. Each of the 4 Gospels is a distinct story written to help a specific group of worshippers grow in faith and see Jesus as the Anointed One. The goal of the Gospel of Luke is to provide a detailed, chronological account of Jesus' life, ministry, death, and resurrection, with a particular focus on Jesus' compassion and message of salvation for the marginalized and outcast, including Gentiles, Samaritans, women, and the poor.

As we read each day, I ask that you....

- Take a few slow deep breaths
- Ask God to help you let go of your thoughts and take in the reading
- Read the scripture passage
- Reflect what portion drew you in the most and why?
- Pray ask God, "What do you want me to gain from this reading?"
- Hold Hold what you think God is saying to you in the scripture as you go about the day.

As you read the book of Luke open your mind and heart to the truth that God is always within you and guiding you.

Each of us is on a journey as an individual, but also as a member of the church. How is God guiding you to get more connected to specific people in the church? How is God guiding you to get more involved? If you are extremely involved, how is God guiding you to invite others to share in responsibilities of the church?

As we read through Luke, realize that our community of faith is called by God to welcome and invite to people that long to experience God's love, peace, and hope in their lives.




